## Abstract and Full Paper Format

### Abstract Format:

The abstract title is limited to 300 characters and the abstract text to 2000 characters, excluding spaces but including punctuation, for the text of your submission. It should describe briefly your paper: key motivation for the study, objective, information on the location and data used, methodology and results. Authors should be identified with the key author underlined. Key words should be indicated. Also to be indicated on the right top corner of the abstract is the theme (i.e. Theme 1, 2, 3 or 4) where the presentation will be considered.

### Full Paper Format:

Each paper must be in English (US) with the content arranged as follows:

Title of the study/paper (no more than 15 words)

Author's/Authors' complete name, affiliation, and address (omit social titles). Key author underlined

Abstract (maximum of 300 words)

Key words

Main Text

Reference (use the Chicago Manual of Style [CMOS 16th edition] author-date format)

Tables

Figures

NOTE: The length of each paper/article must not exceed 8,000 words. It must be submitted as an MS word file, typed double-spaced on an A4 paper setting

### Tables, Figures and Measurements

Each table and figure (accompanied by the original tabulated data) must be on a separate sheet of paper, numbered in order and placed at the end of the article/paper.

Text for tables and figures should not be smaller than 9 points. Scanned or digital photos should be in high resolution (minimum of 300 dpi).

All measurements should be expressed using International System of Units (SI). National units such as cavan, rai, chupa, should be avoided (in cases when these could not be avoided, the equivalent values in SI units must be shown). The US dollar equivalent should be given when other monetary units are used.
