**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 5-YEAR CALIBATO LAKE BASIN
DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, under Laguna Lake Development Authority Board Resolution No. 464, Series of 2014, the LLDA adopted the "Framework for the Formulation of Development and Management Plan (DMP) for the Seven Crater Lakes of San Pablo City";

WHEREAS, the Framework is aimed at formulating a Development and Management Plan (DMP) for each of the Seven Crater Lakes by involving concerned government agencies, non-government organizations, and all major stakeholders in addressing the lakes' environmental degradation as well as other issues that may be identified during the process of plan formulation;

WHEREAS, Calibato Lake is the third largest among the seven crater lakes and holds the biggest volume of water with around 29.45 million cubic meters (about 3 million cubic meters less the total volume of the other six crater lakes) being the deepest lake with estimated mean depth of 68.01 meters and maximum recorded depth of 135 meters;

WHEREAS, Calibato Lake is located within two (2) protected areas, namely: Mt. Banahaw and San Cristobal Protected Landscape and Malabanban Cabunsod Watershed Forest which make it a vital basin for water and biodiversity conservation and protection;

WHEREAS, it is important to conserve, protect and restore the Calibato Lake Basin for its provisional (water supply, fish, irrigation crops, wood, fuel, etc.), regulating (flood and drought mitigation, self-purification, health provision, climate mediation, habitat, and diverse food chain), cultural (aesthetic and scenic values, religious and spiritual values, historic site and educational resources), and supporting services (soil properties, habitat formation, primary production and nutrient cycling);

WHEREAS, the formulation of Calibato Lake DMP was conducted through a series of consultation meetings and workshops with the full engagement of all the key stakeholders during the whole planning process which include the following major activities: lake basin assessment, stakeholder mapping and analysis, problem analysis, objectives analysis, alternatives analysis, developing project design matrices and formulation of plan of operations;

WHEREAS, the Calibato Lake DMP, completed by following the Framework for the Formulation of Development and Management Plan for the Seven Crater Lakes, is considered a living document or a work in progress where changes and improvements can be incorporated and integrated by the stakeholders towards a full and powerful document for sustainability and inter-generational equity;

THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, **BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to acknowledge and approve the Calibato Lake Development and Management Plan, for consequent adoption of the recipient Local Government Units (LGUs) and the local community in Calibato Lake Basin;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that any changes or improvements incorporated and integrated by the stakeholders in the Calibato Lake DMP shall be subject to ratification of the LLDA Board.


