**APPROVING THE 5-YEAR PALAKPAKIN LAKE DEVELOPMENT
AND MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Laguna Lake Development Authority adopted the "Framework for the Formulation of Development and Management Plan (DMP) for the Seven Crater Lakes of San Pablo City, Municipality of Nagcarlan, and Municipality of Rizal in Laguna Province" in pursuant to Board Resolution No. 464, Series of 2014;

WHEREAS, the Framework is aimed at formulating a Development and Management Plan for each of the Seven Crater Lakes by involving concerned government organizations, non-government organizations, and all major stakeholders in addressing the lakes' environmental degradation as well as other issues that may be identified during the process of plan formulation;

WHEREAS, Palakpakin Lake is teemed with issues and challenges that threatened its existing use for fishery being the home of native aquatic fishes and the famous "Hipong Palakpakin" which is a native delicacy in San Pablo City;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to formulate a DMP for Palakpakin Lake to ensure that it is conserved, protected and restored to continually benefit the local community and other stakeholders depending on its important aquatic resources;

WHEREAS, the formulation of Palakpakin Lake DMP was materialized through a series of consultation meetings and workshops with the full engagement of all the key stakeholders during the whole planning process which include the following major activities: lake basin assessment, stakeholder mapping and analysis, problem analysis, objectives analysis, alternatives analysis, developing project design matrices and formulation of plan of operations;


